



## **Rebuilding the Public Health Workforce**

**March 31, 2022**

### ***Overview***

In mid-April, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) will be releasing a landmark Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) to help reinvigorate and rebuild public health infrastructure, *Strengthening U.S. Public Health Infrastructure, Workforce, and Data Systems*. This \$3 billion five-year initiative will support “critical infrastructure needs related to workforce, foundational capabilities, data modernization, and physical infrastructure.” Component A grantees will be health departments; Component B grantees will be organizations supporting the successful implementation of Component A grantees’ activities.
